Savour the Tastes of New Mosaic Stadium

Regina, Saskatchewan – Fans at the new Mosaic Stadium test game on October 1, 2016, can leave the cooking to us. A full selection of food and beverages will be served when the gates open at noon.

Evrax Place (operated by the Regina Exhibition Association Limited) is bringing in local food vendors to test out some tasty treats and make sure guests have plenty of options to keep their bellies full as they take in the game. A variety of food items and beverages will be for sale through temporary portable food stations inside the stadium.

“Food and beverage services are an important part of the stadium experience,” says Graham Edge, Vice-President of Food and Beverage for the Regina Exhibition Association Limited, the operator of Evrax Place. “When the stadium opens in 2017, we’ll offer food and beverage options based on major market trends in other stadiums and the need to give our guests more choice and convenience.”

At the October 1 game, fans can expect a taste of what’s to come next year. Traditional fare from Dome Concessions like burgers, hotdogs and popcorn will be available along with these mouthwatering items:

- “Fan vs. Food” options from Rock Creek Tap and Grill include Baja Nachos loaded with smoked beef brisket, tomatoes, green onions, black beans, sour cream and salsa smothered in a signature chipotle cheese sauce. For serious appetites, fans can indulge in the Lineman—Rock Creek’s custom made, two-foot-long hotdog with a full pound of meat, loaded up to fans’ delight.
- Beer Bros. will serve football-themed food like the Gridiron Sandwich with beer-braised warm beef and a Pig Skin Sandwich with pulled pork, crackling, bacon and slaw. A mac ‘n’ cheese bowl and pretzels will also be on the menu.
- Wok Box will serve delicious dishes like Butter Chicken with naan and rice, Mongolian Chicken stir fry with rice, and vegetarian spring rolls.
- Western Pizza will have their fan-favourite boneless dry ribs with sauce, along with four types of pizza.
- Coney Island Café will delight fans with double stacked burgers, along with decadent smokies and hotdogs.
- For those who have a sweet tooth, fresh and gooey caramel corn, Nutella-stuffed chocolate chip cookies and a sundae on a stick are among the items from Sweet Ambrosia Bakeshoppe. To commemorate the game, Sweet Ambrosia will also offer a special-edition University of Regina Rams cookie for fans to enjoy as they cheer on the home team.
- Beer, pop, water and hot chocolate will also be for sale.

The food items and vendors at Saturday’s test game are a sign of things to come when new Mosaic Stadium opens in 2017.

“We’ll be working on finalizing contracts for food vendors over the next few months once we have a better idea of equipment needs,” says Edge. “The October 1 game gives an opportunity to test out food items and see what fans like. We hope these local restaurants will be part of the future stadium food experience.”
