FROST Regina Announces Full Schedule Tickets available now

FROST Regina has released the full 2026 schedule.

Events across the city will include skating, Indigenous games, horse and wagon rides, live theatre, dogsledding and the FROST hop circuit brewery tour.

Tickets are now available for Disney's Frozen – The Broadway Musical, which will play at Globe Theatre from January 28 to March 1. The Globe Theatre main floor lobby will be open during FROST for residents to warm up and enjoy some of the magic of Frozen. The Globe will offer a Frozen balloon installation for photo opportunities, hot chocolate and cookies for sale and Frozen-inspired hair styling.
